



Bruce Lee World Convention

London, England—1,600 enthusiastic Bruce Lee fans assembled in Westminster Central Hall to see a program of films, slide and martial arts demonstrations organized by Norman Borine and Randy Wong of *The World of Bruce Lee*, with the assistance of Kenneth Low of the University of Southern California (see *FIGHTING STARS* December 1979). Dan Inosanto was the star giving demonstrations of the Filipino stick art of kali and of jeet kune do, the unarmed combat system developed by Bruce Lee.

Randy Wong reported to *FIGHTING STARS* that the crowd gave Inosanto a standing ovation and when he left the stage, hundreds of fans rushed forward and attempted to touch him. He was escorted from the hall by Norman Borine and Jeff Imada while an announcer implored the fans to return to their seats.

The eight-hour program was concluded with a showing of *Return of the Dragon*.

Other martial artists who gave demonstrations were two wing chun stylists, Simon Lau of London and James Lew of Los Angeles.
